PRESENTATION

Caen National University is the promoter of the fifteenth Joint Seminar on Geo-Environmental Engineering GEE 2016 in Nantes, France, in collaboration with the Coastal French Association and Paralia (registration management), the IMN Material Institute of Nantes and the territorial and industrial partners (local organization committee).

This conference follows up the fourteenth Japan-Korea-France-Canada Joint Seminar on Geo-Environmental Engineering held at Concordia University, Montreal, Quebec (Canada) in 2015 planned by the GEE organizers, but with a stress on corporation activity and intended for all countries.

These two and half days GEE 2016 Conference comprise the June, 1st as welcome day for GEE organizers, one day of conference (June, 2nd) work including oral presentations and posters in parallel sessions and finally the June, 3rd dedicated to technical visits bearing on important geo-environmental engineering projects.

The goals of this GEE 2016 Conference, are:

- up-to-date knowledge acquisition as far as geo-environmental engineering in the world is concerned;
- allowing exchange of ideas between specialists on concerned subjects;
- promoting comparison of analyses and experience between researchers and public and private sectors;
- presenting new material and techniques, together with the available documents (if technical stands);
- developing Japan-Korea-France-Canada inter-university and inter-corporation collaborations.

LAST CALL FOR PAPERS

Last call for papers is maintained but the full paper will be due as soon as possible!

The official language is English. Papers, absolutely original, will be pre-selected by the chairpersons of the organizing committee of GEE 2016 Conference, (abstracts), followed by the review panel under the supervision of this committee (acceptance of the paper, corrections and choice of oral presentation or poster).

Communications will be held either in the form of an oral presentation which will last 15 minutes including discussion, or as a poster presentation for 5 minutes. They will be collected in a book of communications, delivered at the conference and on USB key.

Some of the papers presented orally or as posters at the conference will be selected and proposed for publication in special issues of journals relative to the civil, coastal and geo-environmental engineering and management (list of journals will be given in the bulletin n°3).

Special awards will be delivered to young researchers in different sessions on the topics outlined above.

PAPER SUBMISSION

Last registration and papers should be submitted imperatively before April 30th, 2016 at the following email address: daniel.levacher@unicaen.fr

Papers should include: the title, the author(s) name(s) and a text from 2 to 8 pages. Writing of the manuscript should be formatted in strict accordance to the instructions to authors of the journal Revue Paralia available online at <http://www.paralia.fr>.

The acceptance of the papers will be communicated on April 22th, 2016.

The authors have to send back the final version of the accepted manuscripts before May 6th, 2016.
